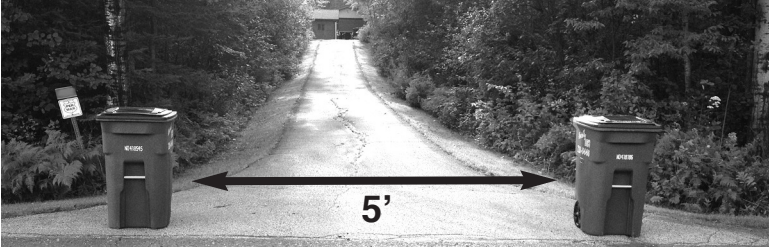


Your Attention is Needed ***AUTOMATED PICK-UP***



AUTOMATED EQUIPMENT is used to improve efficiency and increase our driver's safety. Our system allows for pick-up on both sides of the street/alley/road. Help us to help you keep prices down.

- Place one cart on each side of driveway or at least 5 feet apart.
- Place carts out by 5:30 am or the night before.
- Place with handles and wheels facing away from driving lane.
- Place carts closer to driving lane, within 3 feet.
- Place away from obstructions like poles, trees parked cars, fences, and garages.
- Remove any temporary bungee cords or tie-downs.
Tip: If animals are a problem, spray bleach or pepper mixture under the lid of cart!
- Place cart where driver leaves it after pick-up.**
- We picked-up your trash today.
To continue service, please call our office.
- We picked-up your trash today, but your service is **every other week**. Your next pick-up will be:

- We walked in for your trash today, but next time it must be in place for pick-up by 5:30 am.
 - We can not take this item with your regular trash.
Please call office to arrange a Special Pick-up.
 - We picked-up your cart today but it was blocked by parked cars. Place cart between cars when possible.
 - Shovel a path wide enough for the cart to roll thru along with a 5 foot space between carts.
 - Please use H/DBJ cart.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN YOUR TRASH

Based on Minnesota law, certain types of waste are banned from household trash. Solid waste haulers are restricted from collecting these materials. Listed below are special types of waste that haulers are unable to collect.

- Hazardous Waste:** paints and paint products, fluorescent tubes and ballasts, CFL bulbs, asbestos, pesticides and poisons
- Batteries:** automobile batteries, rechargeable batteries
- Chemicals:** motor oils, gasoline, antifreeze, cleaning products, others
- Explosives:** ammunition, gun powder, propane tanks
- Medical Waste:** needles or syringes, infectious materials
Don't put our employees lives in danger. Dispose of medical sharps/needles properly. Place in a puncture resistant container, such as a detergent bottle or plastic soda bottle with a screw top lid. Label: **MEDICAL SHARPS.**

- Tires and Yard Waste** (see below)
- Appliances:** stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, microwaves
- Electronics:** tv's, computers, monitors, printers
